**The Young Mountaineer**

A young mountain climber called Ana always wanted to climb the 15 highest mountains in the world. She is only 21 and now she's done it. She's the youngest female climber to complete the challenge. Ana was born in the mountains of France. Her parents were German, but before Ana was born they moved to a village near Mont Blanc, the tallest mountain in Europe. As a child of five or six, Ana dreamed of climbing it. At 13, she finally did it. She read about famous mountaineers in a magazine, and started to dream of bigger mountains. 'I thought it would be a fantastic challenge and a lot of fun,' she said.

Ana's father, a climbing instructor, went with her on 13 of the 15 mountain climbs. On one of the climbs she met her best friend, Silvia. This was while she was training on Mont Blanc. It's still the mountain she loves most. Silvia climbed two of the highest mountains with Ana, including the famous Mount Everest.

In 2014, she finished the challenge by climbing the final mountain, Mount Lhotse, in Nepal. She was interviewed by the climbing magazine she always read as a teenager. Ana said that she saw wild bears, snow leopards and mountain goats. While climbing, she got an idea to start a charity to help the poor children who live there. She is currently training to be a teacher, and wants to open a school near Mount Lhotse.
